

Cornwall Aero Modellers Distancing Guidelines

Applicable as of May 19th, 2020

In view of the Covid-19 crisis, social distancing and hand hygiene will be with us for the rest of the year, so we will have to deal with this new reality. A number of common-sense procedures should govern our behavior when visiting the field.

These include the following:

- 1) Stay home if you don't feel well or have symptoms. Follow screening and self-isolation protocols.
- 2) Keep your distance (2 meters minimum). Masks aren't mandatory but use one if you prefer. You do not have to wear a mask when you are standing on the line, flying a plane.
- 3) Set-up tables should be placed 10-20 feet apart.
- 4) Assume surfaces handled by others are infected. Supply your own cleaners, disinfectant, wipes, paper towels, etc. Please take your garbage home.
- 5) Avoid sharing equipment; if you do, clean the tools before and after.
- 6) Wash/disinfect your hands before you touch your face.
- 7) Except for people who share a household, there will be no guests allowed at the field for the time being.
- 8) The main gate lock user should sanitize his hands after handling the lock and gate.
- 9) When parking, try to leave a reasonable space between vehicles.
- 10) No more than one person at a time should enter the clubhouse. Each member must sign-in as soon as he arrives at the field, so that we have a record of attendees in case someone develops symptoms of the virus.
- 11) When using the restroom, please wipe down any surfaces you touch with disinfectant.
- 12) Storage trailer access will be for maintenance work only. Lock up again as soon as task is completed.
- 13) The BBQ will be off-limits for now. Members must bring their own food, drink and utensils for their own consumption.

14) It is also advisable to bring your own chair.
